QUEENSLAND LIGHTING INNOVATION AWARDS (LiIA) INVITATION

The Queensland Chapter of the Illuminating Engineering Society of Australia and New Zealand is now inviting designers of luminaires to nominate for the (new) 2019 Queensland Lighting Innovation Awards.

Nominations are not restricted to members of the Society but are open to any person designing new luminaires including architects, lighting designers, interior or industrial designers and luminaire manufacturers.

Events such as the Lighting Innovation Awards represent the Chapter's most important contribution to the recognition and promotion of the art and science of illuminating engineering in Queensland. As well as giving acclaim to designs of high standard, the Society believes that in promoting the awards, the concept of professionalism in the industry is enhanced and the importance of lighting and luminaire design is publicly acknowledged.



There are four categories of entry:

- Category A Concept Design,
- Category B Working Model,
- Category C In Production, and
- Category D Bespoke (or one-off).

In 2019 the Queensland Chapter is running a pilot for a new online awards entry process to streamline processes. More information is available on the Awards section of the website and regular updates will be provided to Queensland members. A checklist is available on the website for entrants to assist in the preparation of your entry and we encourage you to assemble the required materials before you start to lodge your entry online. In 2019 to enter these awards entrants are required to:

- Read and comply with the **Conditions of Entry** available on the IESANZ website
- **Obtain Owners Consent** to submit the project and provide to the IESANZ by the entry closing date this form is available for download on the IESANZ website
- Provide the required entry materials in the formats specified, including high definition photographic images featuring the entry that can be used at the Annual Awards Dinner
- Be prepared to provide details of the number of additional certificates and/or trophies that you may wish to order, if successful
- Complete the **online entry form** available at https://www.iesanz.org/awards-2/awards-2019-queensland
- Pay the required entry fee (online payment options are provided upon completion of the online entry form) and submit proof of payment with each entry, by the entry closing date

Entry Fees must be paid for the award entry to be considered for judging and the preferred payment method is via credit card using the online system. To receive the member rate for the entries fees you will need to login to the website using your membership details.
