

Flicker – Why care?

- **Photo epilepsy** – flashing lights stimulate epileptic seizures
- **Stroboscopic effect** – **dangerous** when working with rotating machinery
- **Migraine** or severe headache
- Increased repetitive behavior among persons with autism
- Asthenopia (**eye strain**), including fatigue, blurred vision, etc.
- Other: panic attacks, anxiety, increased heart rate, dizziness
- Also: **interference with imaging devices** (video & security cameras, etc.)
