

## TECHNICAL MEETING

### Phsyics of Sky Glow

At a recent technical meeting, Dr. Gillian Isoardi gave an insightful presentation on the growing issue of light pollution, speaking directly to those of us in the lighting industry. She highlighted how uncontrolled artificial light is not only affecting wildlife—disrupting their natural behaviors—but also reducing humanity's ability to experience the night sky, with many people no longer able to see the Milky Way due to excessive light. It was a clear reminder of the far-reaching impacts of our work as lighting professionals.

What stood out in Dr. Isoardi's talk was her focus on how we, as an industry, can be part of the solution. She emphasized the need for responsible lighting design and called on us to start important discussions around better practices that reduce unnecessary light. It was a thoughtful presentation that encouraged us all to consider how we can contribute to positive change in managing light pollution.
