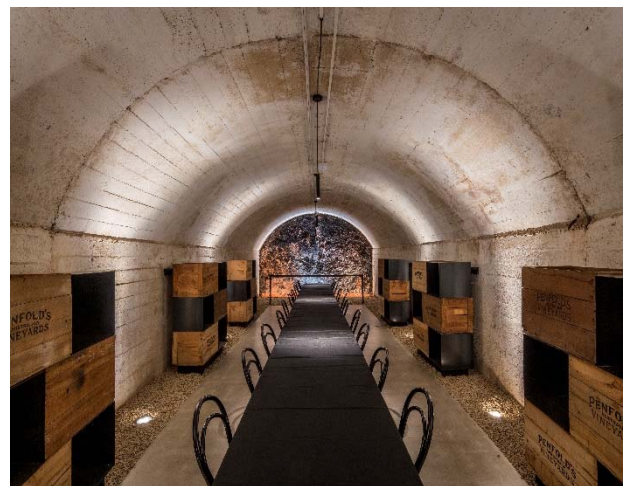


Award of Commendation – Penfolds Magill Estate

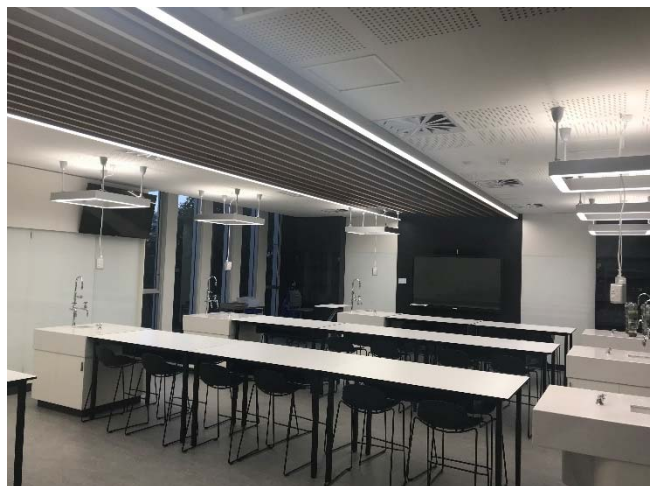


Award of Excellence – Concordia College Science Centre
