Recently we've been involved with MBIE, with your NZ Chapter being invited to lead the writing of an acceptable solution and verification method for NZBC G7 (daylighting). Public consultation has now wound up and we are about to start work on the final version taking into account the comments received. Being invited by MBIE to write these updates is fantastic recognition of the experience and expertise that IESANZ (through our members) can bring to government and territorial authorities. In particular, it is great to get recognition from Richard London (Manager Building Performance – MBIE) as follows "We are nearing the release date (6 April) for the annual update programme, this includes the G7 updates that IES have been helping draft and develop. While the new documents will only formally acknowledge the Singaporean Government for use of copyright content. I'd like to formally acknowledge the excellent work the society has put in to enable the new documents to become a reality. I want to specifically single out Ewen for his long hours and commitment to meeting our ambitious timeframes. Without it we would be waiting until next years update cycle.

Thank you again, your society members can be proud of your contribution to improving daylighting in New Zealand."

This is a fantastic commendation, well done and thank you to Ewen Cafe and all of the working committee members for your contribution.
