Earthquake Restraint and Design Requirements – What's Changed & What's Stayed The Same?

Are you updated on the current requirements and any changes that have occurred since DPTI's last release of guidelines including the new Ministers Specification – Upgrading Health and Safety in *Existing Buildings?*

In 2014 the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) released guidelines and design criteria to assist everyone engaged in the building industry to be familiar with the application of structures to which the AS1170.4 applies.

Whilst we take for granted that the engineering of a structure is sufficient to withstand an earthquake event, it is equally as important to understand the need / requirement to install devices that limit horizontal and vertical movement of non-structural parts and components in these buildings.

It should not be forgotten that Adelaide is in an area that has a higher risk of earthquake activity than many other cities in Australia. Magnitude 5.0 to 6.0 have been experienced in Adelaide in 1954 and therefore consideration of that risk resulted

in the development of the Australian Standard 1170.4 – Structural Design Actions – Earthquake Actions.
